- Pop health updates (by Shannon Riley)
 - Highlight has been front porch awareness campaigns with involvement from a diverse mix of staff and students, been avenue for new clients getting enrolled and finding out about HCH services
 - What is pop health (see slide)
 - Some Things we did this year(see slide)
 - Grant-related + pilot work
 - BCCP grant pilots around breast and cervical cancer screening reminder cards
 - Partnered with Comms and medical/MAT on one-pagers to promote client education (including self-identifying if at risk for HIV)
 - OB tracking
 - Findings from year: uninsured clients for the most part got connected to prenatal care in a timely fashion so will be stopping tracking of this population
 - 2023 priorities conveyed around preventive care, immunization efforts, chronic conditions, infectious disease prevention and treatment
- PI updates (by Tracy Russell)
 - Quality KPI dashboard update
 - Highlighted which measures saw improvement since month prior + deterioration since month/quarter prior
 - Breast cancer screenings went up by 3% outcome of outreach calls using registry of clients past due
 - Lab notification tracking went up by 6% to 25%
 - SDH ask rate declined since last guarter (50% down to 42%)
 - Highlighted the UDS measures that met goal, were close to meeting goal, and that made large improvements during the course of the year (see slides)
 - Flu season + tripledemic call to encourage clients to get vaccinated for Flu (17%) and COVID (7%)
 - o 2022 PI goals: reviewed which were met, close to meeting, and not met (see slide)
 - Update on client surveys (see slide)
 - Almost final 2023 PI goals
 - 2023 PI work attendees encouraged to reach out with interest in participating, ideas on how to meet with frontline staff in a way that isn't burdensome.
