

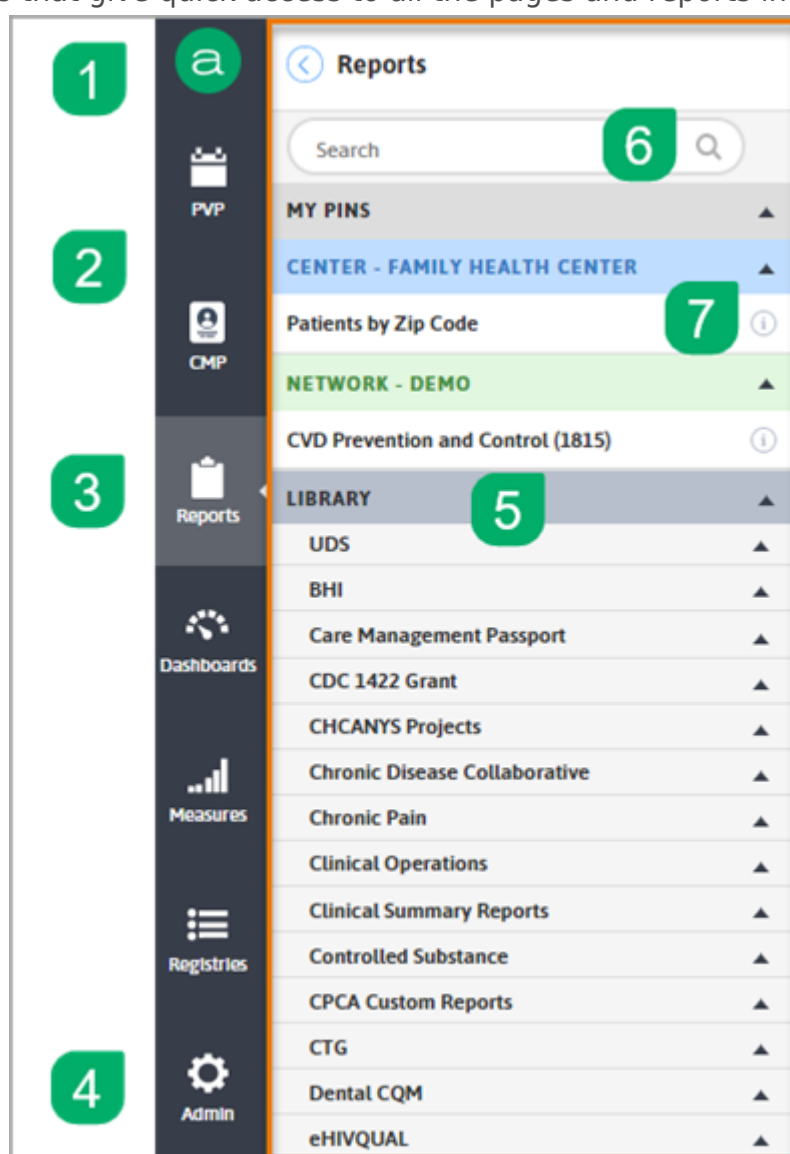


Navigating Through DRVS

The DRVS application is designed to make it easy for you to quickly navigate to the reports and measures that matter the most to you.

Left-Hand Navigation Bar

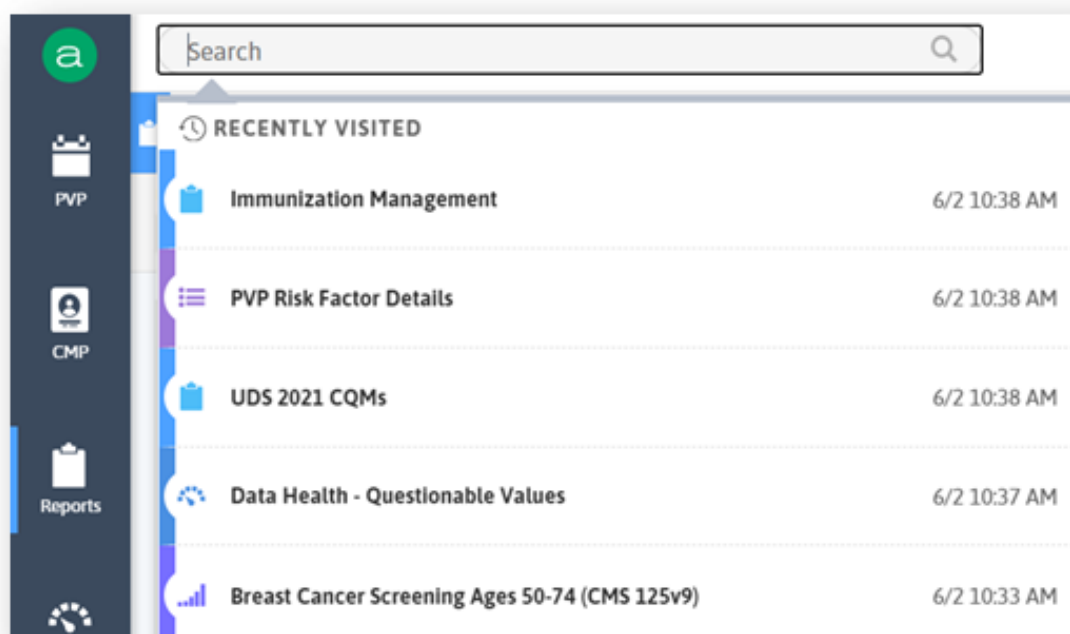
The Left-Hand Navigation bar, also called the “Left Nav”, is located on the left side of all pages. The Left Nav has global icons that give quick access to all the pages and reports in DRVS.



1. Click the Azara icon from any page to go directly to the Home Page.
2. Clicking the PVP (Patient Visit Planning) or CMP (Care Management Passport) takes you directly to the report.


3. Click the Reports, Dashboards, Measures, or Registries icons to open the list of all reports available. The screenshot shows the opened Reports menu.
4. Click the Admin icon to access the main Admin page.
5. The Library menu lists all the available options under categories. Click a category to expand its list. Custom Reports are located at the end of the menu list. Hover over the info icon next to any report name for more detailed information. The info icon is especially useful in the Measures menu where some measures are listed in multiple categories or are similar to other measures. The info icon lets you quickly verify you are selecting the correct measure.
6. Use the search bar at the top of the list to type the name or keyword for a report. Make your selection from the list of suggested reports.
7. Any reports you have pinned are listed under **My Pins**. If your network or practice have shared pinned reports for your use, they will also be listed here.




Global Search

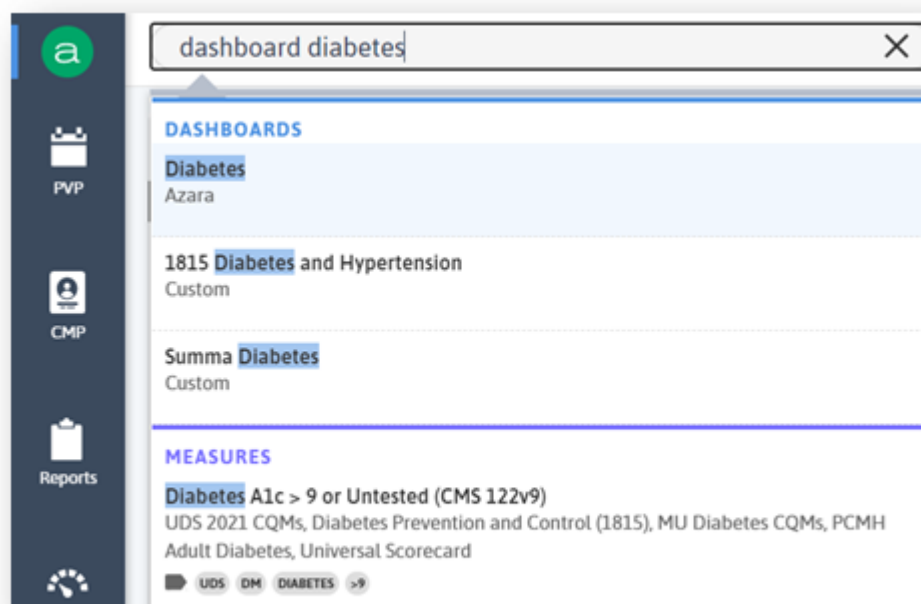


Users can also navigate through DRVS using the Global Search bar at the top left of any page. The global search will display the six (6) most recent pages you have visited in DRVS and the date and time you visited them.

The different icons indicate different types of pages:

-  The blue clipboard represents a report.

-  The blue gauge represents a dashboard.
-  The purple bar chart represents a measure.
-  The purple list represents a registry.



The global search also allows users to search for specific pages in DRVS by key word or phrase. Using the type of page (report, dashboard, measure, or registry), users can limit the returned search results even further. The search results will display pages based on the name, category, and tags of an object.

There is a default summary scorecard on your home page. You have the option of

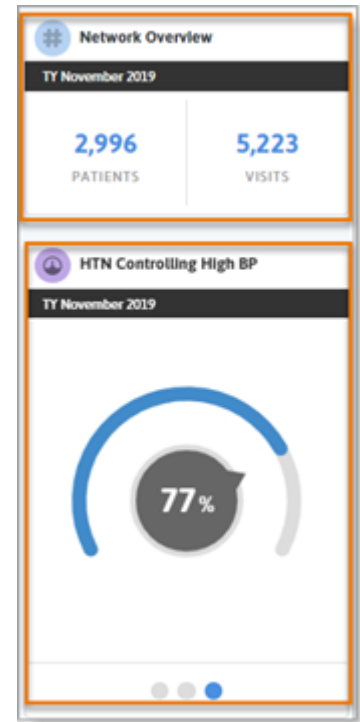

14 Measures

1. Click on any measure name to drill down for a more detailed analysis through the Measure Analyzer.
2. Results are listed. If a target has been established for a measure, the results are color coded as red, yellow or green, based on how the results meet the targets.
3. The change against a set baseline time period is listed as a percentage, with a color-coded arrow showing whether the results have improved or worsened.
4. Click the Full Report link to access the full scorecard report.

Performance Indicators



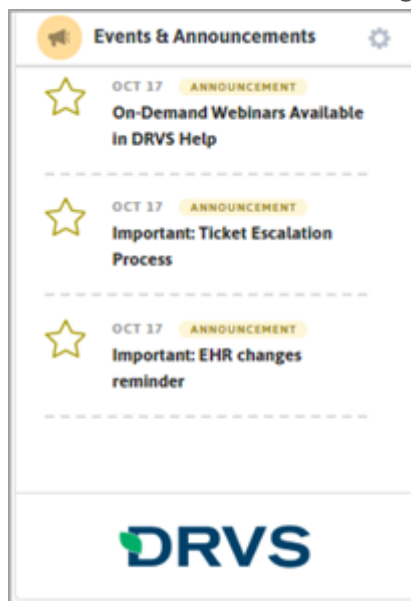
In the practice of the home page are easy-to-read performance indicators for your organization and/or network.

Below, a three-measure carousel widget is displayed. The displayed measure will automatically change every 10 seconds, or click the dots below to manually view the other measures.

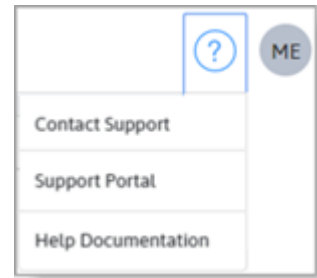
Events & Announcements

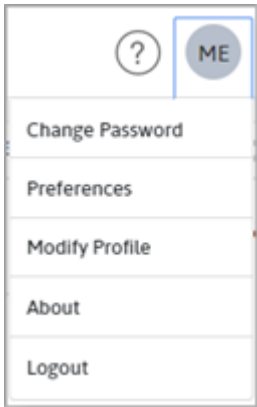


Help and Profile
