

Referring patients for convalescent care

The Health Care for the Homeless Convalescent Care Program (CCP) gives patients without housing a place to rest, recover, and get care following acute illness and injury.



1. Review eligibility

Age and location	Short-term medical need	Level of independence and stability
 18+ years Referring agency in Baltimore City or County 	Examples: • Post-op recovery • Wound care • Foley or ostomy management	 No need for overnight support No oxygen tank or IV antibiotics No infectious disease that requires isolation (i.e. COVID, monkeypox) Can manage own ADLs Can tolerate a group living environment

4. Before discharge, you must...

Schedule all of the patient's follow-up appointments and provide two weeks of medications and wound care supplies.
