



Referring patients for convalescent care

The Health Care for the Homeless Convalescent Care Program (CCP) gives patients without housing a place to rest, recover, and get care following acute illness and injury.



1. Review eligibility

Age and location	Short-term medical need	Level of independence and stability
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 18+ years• Referring agency in Baltimore City or County	Examples: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Post-op recovery• Wound care• Foley or ostomy management	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No need for overnight support• No oxygen tank or IV antibiotics• No infectious disease that requires isolation (i.e. COVID, monkeypox)• Can manage own ADLs• Can tolerate a group living environment

Clients on methadone or buprenorphine are eligible. **For full details, see the referral form.**



2. Call our referral line at 410-598-6758

See whether there's room in our 16-bed facility and confirm eligibility. The referral line operates Monday-Friday, 8 a.m.–4:30 p.m. (excluding holidays).



3. Fax over the referral form to 443-703-1117

We'll notify you of acceptance within 24 hours.



4. Before discharge, you must...

Schedule all of the patient's follow-up appointments and provide two weeks of medications and wound care supplies.
