## Join our Certified Outpatient Substance Use Program

### Eligibility

- ✓ 18 and older
- ✓ Experiencing or at risk of homelessness

### Assessment

**Walk-in assessments are available daily**

**Where:** 421 Fallsway

**When:** Monday- Wednesday, Friday: 7 a.m.-12 p.m. & 1-2:30 p.m.  
Thursday: 7 a.m.-12 p.m.

**We'll assess and assign you to an ongoing addiction counselor or behavioral health therapist and one or more of our substance use services:**

- Daily substance use disorder groups, including weekly men’s and women’s groups
- Medication-assisted treatment (MAT)
- Individual one-on-one counseling
- Syringe services
- Tools for safer substance use

### Intensive Outpatient (IOP)

**When:** Monday – Friday, 8-11 a.m.

**Where:** 3<sup>rd</sup>-floor group room

### Outpatient (OP)

**When:** Tuesday and Thursday, 11 a.m.-12 p.m.

**Where:** 3<sup>rd</sup>-floor group room
